**Scripture:** Revelation 12|7-9

1. This describes a great war in heaven between good and evil. How have you experienced this in your own life?
2. What emotions or thoughts stir up in you knowing that Satan has been defeated?
3. If we know that Satan has been defeated, why do you think we give him a foothold in our hearts so often?

**Scripture:** Revelation 12|10-11

4. Even in his defeat, Satan uses 3 tools against us; accusation, deception, and intimidation. Which one of these represents the way Satan attacks you most often?
5. Verse 11 talks about the power of our testimony and we see this elsewhere (1 Peter 3:15). What fears or reservations do you have when presented the opportunity to share your testimony?
6. God has claimed victory and His power is real, what would change in your life if you realized that you have access to that power through Christ?

**Scripture:** Revelation 13|16-18

7. The "mark of the beast" is an image of those who are marked by the stench of Satan. As Christ-followers, what are some ways we can live godly lives to set an example for others?
8. The "Seal of the Spirit" is an image of God's protection over his children. What can you do to develop a practice to help you when you feel the enemy pushing on you?
