**Scripture:** Read John 17|13-19

1. Who would you describe as the holiest person you know, and why?
2. Jesus prayed for his disciples and all believers that came after them to be holy or "set apart." Discuss together how being "not of the world" relates to holiness.
3. It's not hard to get wrapped up in the stuff of this world. What would you consider some of that stuff to be, and why is it so easy to let it consume us?
4. How do we attain holiness through the truth of God's word like Jesus prayed we would in John 17?

**Scripture:** Read Philippians 2|3-8

5. Humility is more than just the opposite of pride. How would you form a definition of humility from the verses you read?
6. Discuss the significance of Jesus taking on human form as an example of his humility.
7. What are some simple but meaningful ways you can personally live out Jesus-style humility?

**Scripture:** Read 1 Corinthians 2|1-5

8. What is it about humility that would cause someone who doesn't follow Jesus to respect someone who does?

9. How can these verses influence how we share the gospel with the people around us?
