Jesus summed up the importance of this relationship							
as the greatest of all the commandments given:							

Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.

MATTHEW 22|37

One of the ways we grow in knowing God is through gathering to worship together weekly. During our weekend services, we collectively worship God through song, prayer, humor, fellowship, and teaching. Worship is simply expressing our love to God.

Worship the Lord your God, and serve Him only.

MATTHEW 4|10B

...true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and in truth.

The Father is looking for those who will worship him that way.

JOHN 4|23B NLT

This means we must worship with both our head and heart. Notice it doesn't say anything about style. Some churches have liturgical worship where everything is very solemn, quiet and orderly. Others are charismatic and emotional. 2|42 is somewhere in the middle of this. The point is not the style of the worship environment, only that it's done in spirit and truth. The worship environment in a church should be about bringing honor and glory to God and teaching biblical truth.

Like any other relationship in our lives, a relationship with God takes work, communication, and quality time. Prayer is how we talk with God. Jesus modeled and taught a consistent rhythm of prayer. This is why having a daily encounter is such an important part of following Jesus, and such an important part of the Rooted experience. Jesus encouraged us like this:

But when you pray, go into your room, close the door and pray to your Father, who is unseen. Then your Father, who sees what is done in secret, will reward you.

MATTHEW 6|6

Growing with others is all about following Jesus by	developing relationships with God's people, the church
This is about experiencing	by growing with others through weekly
groups and coaching relationships.	

This is the inward dimension to our spiritual lives. God didn't just create us to worship Him personally, but also with others. We were created to be in relationships with others. Jesus said that the greatest commandment was to love God, but the second greatest was like it:

Love your neighbor as yourself.

MATTHEW 22|39

Like the first church in Acts, we prioritize small groups in order to help people grow with others. In Acts 2 we read about the believers hanging out day after day in the temple and sharing meals in homes. They did life together. This is one of the reasons it is important to commit to meeting weekly with your Rooted group, as you begin to do life together over the next several weeks.

Live a life filled with love, following the example of Christ.

EPHESIANS 5|2A NLT

There are more than 30 commands in the New Testament that we really can't obey unless we are growing with others. These are the "one another" commands. We believe these are best lived out in a small group. Small group communities allow a church to grow big, but still be personal and foster friendships. After completing Rooted, your Rooted group will continue on as a small group. That will allow you to continue building on the community you will have developed through the Rooted experience.
