Acts 2 Church Model

The Acts 2 Church Model is a tool that helps walk through the first response to the movement of the Holy Spirit in [Acts 2:36-47](#). In these verses, we learn [12 key responses](#) that the early church experienced because of the coming of the Holy Spirit. Each of these 12 responses helped build the model for the community of believers throughout the book of Acts. As a church, we help people take steps to grow in depth and experience of how God works in these ways.

ICE BREAKER ACTIVITY
