

➤ KENYA MISSION TRIP 2015 ➤

We will be partnering with a Christian organization called **New Hope Initiative**. It was founded in 2011 in order to bring real positive change to some of the poorest communities in the world. They do that by a multi-faceted approach of nutritional, educational, economic, and spiritual assistance. They partner with respected local leaders and churches in some of the world's most difficult neighborhoods to offer self-sustaining projects of hope that will change a community forever. They accomplish this by leveraging the gifts, talents, and passions of people, like you, all over the world who want to help us make this world a better place. Purpose: Show Christ's love to the people of Kibera by sharing the Gospel with them and uplifting their local projects such as the church, school, medical clinic, and women's ministry that New Hope Initiative has helped them build. Importantly, we hope that this serving experience will humble you, change the way you view the world, and greatly impact your life.

What we will be doing: We will meet to determine the talents/passions of the group to create a customized itinerary fit for our group. Some things we can do are:

- Lead worship/speak at church service/disciple
- Day camp for kindergarten-8th grade (vacation bible school)
- Tutor/mentor high school students sponsored by the Penda Project
- Give medical care/assessments
- Build or construct things wherever needed
- Working with women/mothers of Project Biashara

Date: May 27th –June 7th, 2015 (12 days)

Location: Nairobi, Kenya- we will be working in one of the largest slums in the world called Kibera

Cost: approximately \$1,950-\$2,200 (dependent upon cost of flight & includes EVERYTHING)

Requirements: Passport (get sooner rather than later)

- **DEPOSIT OF \$250 DUE JAN. 11th** (Sunday)- not refundable. Once all of the deposits are in we will have a set cost for the entire trip because flights can be booked.

Lodging: Sandavy Guest House in Nairobi, Kenya (<http://sandavysafaris.com/>)-secure & safe location

Safety: From personal experience, it's a safe place to bring a group. Presuming there is proper staffing and leadership. However, this is not a resort or glamorous place. This is a REAL and raw missions experience. Even though we will not be in dangerous places, we need to be smart and precautious such as leaving the slum before dark.

- Vaccinations at least 4-6 weeks before trip(these are not necessary but recommended)
